OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOLS & OUTDOOR HOT TUBS/SPAS

(Above ground, in-ground, on ground and inflatable)

Please be advised that Chapter 437 of the Brantford Municipal Code defines a swimming pool as a privately owned outdoor tank or body of water used for swimming, wading, diving, or bathing which when filled can contain a depth of 0.5 metres or more of water.

A permit is required for any such swimming pool and adequate required fencing must be installed prior to any water being allowed in such pool.

This notice is made to ensure the safety of all Brantford residents is maintained.

Please be further advised that this by-law has recently been amended to prohibit the discharge of swimming pool wastewater onto adjoining properties unless consent has been granted.

Appointment of Voting Proxy
