New Year's Day	Tuesday, January 1 st	Closed
Family Day	Monday, February 18 th	No restrictions
Good Friday	Friday, April 19 th	Closed
Easter Sunday	Sunday, April 21 st	Closed
Victoria Day	Monday, May 20 th	No restrictions
Canada Day	Monday, July 1 st	No restrictions
Labour Day	Monday, September 2 nd	No restrictions
Thanksgiving Day	Monday, October 14 th	Closed
Christmas Day	Tuesday, December 25 th	Closed

*There are no restrictions on Easter Monday, August Civic
Holiday or Boxing Day.*

The *Retail Business Holidays Act* provides for fines of up to \$50,000 or the total amount of gross sales for the holiday, whichever is greater.

Enforcement of the *Retail Business Holiday Act* in Brockville is the responsibility of the Brockville Police Department.

Complete applications to amend City of Brockville Official Plan and Zoning By-law 050-2014 have been filed with details below.

The Planning and Operations Committee of the City of Brockville will be holding a Public Meeting to give the public an opportunity to make representations concerning proposed Amendments to the City of Brockville Official Plan and Zoning By-law 050-2014.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL:

Subject property: 6 Osment Street
Description of lands: Lots 11 – 14, Block 17, Plan No. 67
Lots 40 – 43 and Part of Lots 36, 38 and 39,
Block 19 Part of Edgewood Avenue
Proposal for the lands: The proposal for the land is to convert the
existing commercial building into a self-service
storage facility with associated outdoor storage.
Proposed OP change: Corridor Commercial Area to Corridor Commercial
Area – Site Specific to permit a Self-Service
Storage Facility and associated Outdoor Storage.
Proposed zoning change: Change from C2 – General Commercial Zone
to C2 – Special Exception Zone to permit a Self
Service Storage Facility with the Storage Units
being a maximum of 30.0 square metres as well
as associated Outdoor Storage to be permitted
within the front yard, but not closer than
4.0 metres to the front lot line (Osment Street).

The subject lands are not the subject of any other application under the Planning Act at this time.

All public comment concerning the proposed amendments shall be heard by the Economic Development Planning Committee at this Public Meeting. Any person may attend this public meeting and make written or oral representations either in support of, or in opposition to, the proposed Amendments.

Comments and opinion submitted on these matters become part of the public record and may be viewed by the general public; and may be published in a Planning Report and Council Agenda. Written requests for notification of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan and/or Zoning By-law Amendment, or refusal of the request, must be made to the Director of Planning for the City of Brockville at the address provided above.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to the City of Brockville before decisions are granted respecting the proposed amendments, the person or public body:

- is not entitled to appeal the decisions of the City of Brockville to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal; and
- may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
